EAST BERLIN, founded in 1764, is an historic town located in Adams County, Pennsylvania. The main street was placed on the national register of Historic Places in recognition of its many early buildings. East Berlin Historical Preservation Society was organized in 1975 to preserve the unique heritage of the town and is responsible for the following five historic buildings:

Red Men's Hall, Church School House, Log House, Swigart's Mill, Liberty #1 Engine House



Healthy Adams Bicycle/Pedestrian, Inc. (HABPI)

The HABPI mission is to promote health and wholesome recreation by developing safe bicycling and pedestrian infrastructure and encouraging these activities for travel and recreation.





Approximately 72% of Adams County residents are overweight, often causing diabetes and heart problems. Studies show that walking and bicycling provide simple exercise that helps people become healthier. In addition, the more people walk or bicycle, even short distances, the less pollution is created and the less fossil fuels we consume. HABPI is working with local governments and organizations to build a pedestrian and bicycling trail in and around Gettysburg Borough. This is the Gettysburg Inner Loop (GIL) Trail. This trail will make it easier for residents to exercise, improve their health, and travel to local key destinations. Money is needed to match state grants for building the trail.

HABPI is also working with the Gettysburg Area Recreation Authority and the Gettysburg National Military Park to create an off-road trail from Gettysburg to Emmitsburg, MD as part of the **Grand History Trail**. Grants were obtained to conduct a trail feasibility study which is being conducted during 2018-2019.

HABPI is an all-volunteer organization with no paid personnel so all donations directly support trail development and related activities.
