When is the Giving Spree?

Where is the Giving Spree?

Where can I drop off my Giving Spree gift before November 5?

Bring your completed Donation Form and gift to the Adams County Community Foundation, 25 South 4th Street, Gettysburg, PA 17325 anytime between now and November 5.



What is the difference between a Today gift and a Forever gift?

On the Donation Form, you'll see that for each nonprofit you choose to make a gift to, you can check either the Today box or the Forever box. If you check Today, your gift will go to the nonprofit right away, to help with immediate needs. If you check Forever, your one-time gift will be added to a designated endowment fund for the specific nonprofit held at the Community Foundation. Each year a grant is made from that fund to the nonprofit, sustaining it for years.



What is a Designated Endowment Fund?

A designated endowment fund provides permanent, annual support for one nonprofit organization. Managed by the Community Foundation, the fund is invested for long-term growth, with annual unrestricted grant distributions helping the nonprofit fulfill its mission for generations to come.



Can I give to a Community Foundation fund not listed here?

Yes! To make a gift to any Adams County Community Foundation fund, use code "004" and fill in the name of the fund on your Donation Form. You can see a complete list of Community Foundation funds at AdamsCountyCF.org.

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What can I give?

You can give by check, credit card, Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD) from your IRA, a gift of stock, or from your donor-advised fund. See ACCFGivingSpree.org for step-by-step instructions on these and other types of gifts.



Is there a gift deadline?

Yes! To qualify for incentives, gifts must be received by **November 5, 2026**. Gifts received **after November 10** will be added to the endowment of the nonprofit(s) you selected.



Are donations tax deductible?

Yes, donations are tax deductible as allowed by law. The charitable status of each nonprofit has been verified by the Community Foundation. The Community Foundation will send you an acknowledgement before December 11, which will serve as your tax receipt. The Community Foundation will send your gift to the nonprofit(s) you selected, which may send you an informal thank-you.



What is the Incentive Pool and can I donate to it?

The Incentive Pool helps all participating nonprofits. At the close of the Giving Spree, the Incentive Pool is distributed to the participating nonprofits in proportion to the amount they raised during the Giving Spree. You can donate to it by including a gift to the Incentive Pool (#114) on the Donation Form.



What are Endowment Prizes and can I donate to them?

Endowment prizes encourage endowment giving. At the close of the Giving Spree, prizes are distributed to the nonprofits with the most Forever gift donors. You can include a gift to Endowment Prizes (#115) on the Donation Form.
